**The Panorama™ prenatal screen is a DNA screening test that provides you with genetic information about your baby.**





# What is NIPT?

Non-invasive prenatal testing (NIPT) uses a blood sample from the mother to analyze DNA from the placenta for certain chromosome conditions that could affect a baby's health.

## **NIPT**<sup>1,2,3</sup>

- Screens for genetic abnormalities such as Down syndrome
- Can identify your baby's gender (optional)
- Has the lowest false positive rate of prenatal screening tests for commonly screened chromosomal abnormalities
- Can be done as early as nine weeks into your pregnancy
- Poses no risk to your baby, unlike amniocentesis and chorionic villi sampling (CVS), which carry a slight risk of miscarriage



# How is Panorama different?

Panorama is the only NIPT that can tell the difference between the mother's and the baby's DNA, which results in:



Fewer false positives and fewer false negatives<sup>1,2,3</sup>



Highest reported gender accuracy of any NIPT (gender reporting is optional\*)<sup>1,2,3</sup>



Ability to detect triploidy, a severe chromosomal abnormality that can result in serious pregnancy complications if unmonitored<sup>5,6</sup>

# Panorama non-invasive prenatal test (NIPT)<sup>1,2,3</sup>

## Chromosome conditions tested:

- Trisomy 21
- Trisomy 18
- Trisomy 13
- Triploidy
- Monosomy X
- Sex-chromosome aneuploidies
- Microdeletions
- Fetal sex (optional)

Timing:  $\geq 9$  weeks

Detection of Down syndrome:  $>99\%$

False positive rate for Down syndrome:  $<1\%$

Risk of miscarriage: None

# What do Panorama results tell me?

Panorama gives you a personalized score and tells you if your baby has a high or low likelihood for screened conditions such as Down syndrome. Like other screening tests, Panorama does not provide a definitive diagnosis of the condition.
